- Audition time preferences will be honored in the order of the receipt of the application.
- The Competition: will be Friday, Feb. 27, and 28 at (times 6:30 − 9:00 pm) at the Faust Harrison Pianos, 322 Black Rock Turnpike, Fairfield, CT. The preliminary performances are private.
- Finalists: will be notified by email no later than 10:30 pm Saturday, Febr. 28th. If you do not receive an email by that time, please contact Mrs. Jordan at nanmj618@gmail.com. Please put this address in your contact list so that it goes in your "inbox."
- Finalists Recital: Finalists will be expected to perform in the finalist recital on the morning of Sunday March 1st, 2026, at 9:30 am at the Faust Harrison Pianos, 322 Black Rock Turnpike, Fairfield, CT (with your accompanist). The winners will be announced at the end of the recital.
- Winners: Three winners will be chosen at the end of the Finalists Recital.
 The winners will get to perform with the American Chamber Orchestra and will receive a cash prize.
- Judges: Decisions of the judges are final, and their comments will be emailed to participants.

- Repertoire: Contestant may play any movement of any major Baroque, Classical, or Romantic Concerto (nothing newer that 1929). Concerti by contemporary composers may not be eligible. (However, works written after 1929 may be performed, but since such performances are subject of copyright protection, all additional performance expenses, including: rentals, royalties or licensing fees are the responsibility of the performer.)
- Choice of music is subject to approval by Chris Hisey, American Chamber Orchestra Music director.
- The music must be memorized and a copy of the music brought to the judges.
- Accompanist: Each contestant is required to bring his/her own accompanist for both the auditions and the recital events.
- Rehearsals: Winners must attend all three rehearsals preceding the concert: Sunday, June 7th time TBA; Thursday, June 11th and Friday, June 12th at 7:30 pm.
- Concert: Winners must perform at the American Chamber Orchestra's Spring Concert on Saturday, June 13th.
- The three winners will need to email a bio and a photo for the website and music program to nammi618@gmail.com.
